STCW VI/2-2 FRB - Fast Rescue Boat Refresher

Purpose:

To give the student elementary knowledge, skills and attitude which make the person able to take the command over a FRB - Fast Rescue Boat under normal and under unusual conditions.

Aim:

After ended course the student will have knowledge, skills and attitude to:

- Take the command over a FRB under and after lowering
- The special characteristics and devices in FRB boats
- The special types of FRB boats
- Deployment of FRB
- Methods to take FRB on board again
- What to do after having left the ship
- Could use a FRB motor, and use of the firefighting equipment in the boat
- Take care of rescued persons and be responsible for the FRB boat
- Could handle a FRB in prevailing weather conditions
- Could use sea anchor and all other equipment on board
- Could perform simple principle for search - search pattern

Prerequisite: Fulfilled STCW VI/2-2 Basic FRB - Fast Recue Boat Course.
